Mayor Baughman called the meeting to order. This special meeting is being held to discuss the future of the village. Baughman reported that we haven't had a zoning inspector for over a year. Verity reported that there are seven council vacancies, no attorney and the clerk is just helping out. Cantrell reported that the speed limit on Main Street could stay at 35mph or go to 50mph if the village is dissolved. Baughman reported that he called ODOT and received no response.

Baughman read the letter he prepared to be sent to the Attorney General asking for a representative to attend the Oct. 17 meeting to discuss dissolving the village.

Council speculated on what would happen to services provided in the Village if the Village was dissolved.

the mosquito spraying (probably stop), snow plowing(according to township priority), liquor licenses (availability may be different), street lights

Currently there is not enough funding available to make any major repairs to the storm drains.

Pierce expressed that people may be starting to realize that they will lose services if the village is dissolved.

Baughman expressed that council members should get more than \$20 per meeting.

Baughman asked Slone what she thought. She expressed that she thinks it's a shame that the town has to go through this and that she doesn't want to see it dissolved.

Cantrell will finish the flyers she's working on and distribute them prior to the Oct 17<sup>th</sup> to ensure that the village residents know what's going on.

Cantrell made a motion to adjourn. Pierce seconded and all agreed. The next scheduled meeting is for Oct. 17, 2005.
