#### AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL BUILDING DEPARTMENTS SEEKING CONTRACT CERTIFICATION

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this <u>Jo</u> day of <u>September</u>, 2010, by and between the Board of County Commissioners, 238 West Sixth Street, Marysville, Ohio 43040, acting for and on behalf of the Union County Building Department, 233 West Sixth Street, Marysville, Ohio 43004, hereinafter called the County, and the Village of Magnetic Springs, 30 Magnetic Street, P.O. Box 150, Magnetic Springs, Ohio 43036, hereinafter referred to as the Village.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Village desires to enforce the Residential Code of Ohio for the purpose of providing uniform standards and requirements for the erection, construction, repair, alteration, and maintenance or residential buildings specified in Section 3781.06 of the Revised Code of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village seeks to obtain the authority for enforcement of the provisions of the Residential Code of Ohio through certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards pursuant to Section 3781.10(E) of the Revised Code, with the condition that the County exercise the enforcement authority and accept and approve plans and specifications, and make inspections in accordance with the Residential Code of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the said Board of Building Standards is in the process of certifying the County to exercise enforcement authority in accordance with the Residential Code of Ohio, effective, as set forth in said Board's certification rule; and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires and is willing to administer to administer and enforce the Residential Code of Ohio within the limits of said Village pursuant to its authority so to do contained in Chapter 3781 of the Revised Code of Ohio and as granted by the Ohio Board of Building Standards; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village has heretofore passed its Ordinance No. 10-03 on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2010, authorizing the Village through its mayor and its clerk to enter into an Agreement with the County, for the enforcement of the Residential Code of Ohio within the limits of said Village; and

WHEREAS, the County has on the <u>new day of Spreamber</u>, 2010, adopted its resolution authorizing the County to enter into said Agreement with the Village, for the purposes aforesaid;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village HEREBY GRANTS TO THE County authority to do all things necessary to exercise enforcement authority and to accept and approve plans and specifications and make inspections necessary with the Village in accordance with the provisions of the Residential Code of Ohio pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 4101:8 – Residential Code of Ohio as promulgated by the Ohio Board of Building Standards, and shall apply and be enforced within the Village.

- <u>Section 2.</u> The County accepts the authority and responsibility to carry out the terms of this Agreement.
- Section 3. The County shall have full authority to do all things necessary to administer and enforce the Residential Code of Ohio within the limits of the Village and in consideration therefore, the County shall retain all permit and inspection fees authorized by the State of Ohio for such purposes.
- Section 4. The effective date for which the County shall begin to perform its duties under this Agreement shall be the date of certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards. This Agreement shall thereafter continue in full force and effect until either of the parties gives written notice to the other, such notice to be given not less than one hundred and eighty (180) days before such termination is to take effect. Written notice of the termination of this Agreement shall also be given to the Board of Building Standards.
- Section 5. The Village hereby agrees to hold the County harmless from all claims or causes of action of every kind and nature arising from the acts of the County, its agents, or employees, or representatives in the administration and enforcement of the Residential Code of Ohio within the limits of said Village.
- Section 6. This Agreement shall be deemed to authorize the County to administer and enforce for the Village any amendments or additions to the Residential Code of Ohio hereafter adopted by the Board of Building Standards or Union County Commissioners pursuant to the authority granted by said Board by Chapter 3781 of the Revised Code of Ohio at all times after said Board shall have adopted such amendments or additions.
- Section 7. The County further agrees to assist the Village in the enforcement of Village ordinances as they relate to residential building and occupancy requirements.
