WHEREAS, mitigation measures for the <u>City/Village</u> and surrounding areas have been analyzed and prioritized, and

WHEREAS, Union County stakeholders have reviewed the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY Council That:

WHEREAS, the Union County Emergency Management Agency desires to be compliant with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, and these acts requires that a Hazard Mitigation program be developed in order that the participating communities and jurisdictions will be eligible for future pre-disaster and post-disaster funding.

WHEREAS, the Union County Emergency Management Agency established the Union County Mitigation Planning Group and have through an organized planning process, identified local hazards and mitigation activities to help reduce damages and loss of life during a disaster. A public meeting was held and the plan was submitted and approved by both the Ohio Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency in 2018. The Plan is on file at the Union County Emergency Management Agency and is hereby formally adopted.

WHEREAS, the Union County All Hazards Mitigation Plan is hereby implemented and must be monitored, evaluated, and updated within a five year cycle. This body will promote and send a representative for the future maintenance of this plan.
