

**VILLAGE OF MAGNETIC SPRINGS  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES FOR April 15th, 1998**

Council members present were: Bob Baughman, Kathy Cantrell, Carol Verity, Rex Pierce, Mayor Bill McCarty and Clerk Lorrie Pheifer. Others in attendance were: Diane Cowgil, Alan Fitzpatrick and Janis Davis. Mayor McCarty called the meeting to order with the reading of the minutes of the March 19th, 1998 meeting. The treasurer's report was given with a balance of \$ total of all village accounts. Cantrell made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as read and pay all bills. Verity seconded the motion. There were no Street Committee, Street Commissioner, or Sewer committee reports at this time.

The magnetic signs will need to be trimmed to fit the new village truck. Pheifer is checking into a fax and copy machine through the state of Ohio purchasing program. Baughman and McCarty stated they would take care of getting the new park benches put together and set in the park. McCarty stated he would get with Dave Phillips concerning the Backhurst property dispute.

In new business McCarty stated he met with Dustin Wilder concerning the renovation of the Union Co. Veterans Building. The group is looking for funding to help with the remodeling project. Baughman stated that the mosquito sprayer is ready for the new season. Janis Davis relayed to council that the gas company had made a large rut in the alley behind her residence that needs to be filled in. McCarty stated he would look into this. Alan Fitzpatrick asked council if they would consider setting aside some funds for the boy scouts to plant flowers at the gazebo. Pierce made a motion to give the scouts \$50.00 for this project and Baughman seconded the motion. All yeas.

Pierce made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Verity seconding the motion. All yeas. The next meeting will be May 14, 1998 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fire House.
