

**VILLAGE OF MAGNETIC SPRINGS
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES FOR Feb. 18, 1999**

Council members present were: Kathy Cantrell, Carol Verity, Bob Baughman, Melissa Stiles, Mayor Bill McCarty and Clerk Lorrie Pfeifer. Others in attendance were Janis Davis, Jeannette Sloan. Mayor McCarty brought the meeting to order with the reading of the Jan. 21, 1999 minutes. Verity made a motion to accept the minutes as read with Cantrell seconding the motion. All yeas. The treasurers report was given with a balance of \$ 38,901.42 total in all village accounts. Baughman made a motion to approve the treasurers report and pay all bills with Cantrell seconding the motion. All yeas.

Mayor McCarty asked for Committee Reports. Verity stated that the storm sewer was backing up into her front yard once again. Baughman made a motion to have Bo's Construction look at the problem and fix it. Verity stated she would contact Bo's construction to schedule a day to look at it.

In old business McCarty stated that the village truck had been fixed and is back in service. McCarty is still waiting on a date from the health department concerning the two houses on Rose Street across from Cantrell. McCarty stated he had not gotten in touch with Flo Fitzpatrick regarding the park. Jeannette Sloan was on hand to relay to council that the park needed to be kept up as children are getting cut on the broken bottles that are scattered within. Sloan also relayed to council that Ohio Edison might come and repair the electric box at the park due to vandalism. McCarty stated he would look into this. Verity suggested holding a clean-up day for the park on 2/20 and 2/27 at 9:00 a.m. Anyone who can come help should do so. McCarty stated he would get with Fitzpatrick to find out about upkeep on park. Baughman informed council that the tenants at the gray house on the corner of Catharine and Main Street owned by Elmer Fuller are continuing to park on the new sidewalk. Baughman suggested possibly putting up a No Parking Sign there. Verity seconded the motion. All yeas.

In new business a Thank You was read from The Union County Sheriff's Department for the monetary contribution from the village for 1998.

Cantrell made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Stiles seconding the motion. All yeas. The next meeting will be March 18, 1999 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fire House.
