

VILLAGE OF MAGNETIC SPRINGS COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES FOR July 9,1998

Council members present were: Bob Baughman, Kathy Cantrell, Carol Verity, Rex Pierce, Ben Laird, Mayor Bill McCarty and Clerk Lorrie Pheifer. Others in attendance were: Janis Davis and Diane Cowgill. McCarty brought the meeting to order with the reading of the minutes of the May 14th meeting. Pierce made a motion to approve the minutes as read with Verity seconding the motion. All yeas. The treasurer's report was given with a balance of \$ 55,392.54 total of all village accounts. Cantrell made a motion to accept the treasurer's report as read and pay all bills. Laird seconded the motion. All yeas.

There were no Street Committee, Street Commissioner, or Sewer committee reports at this time.

In old business Verity stated the tile by her property is working for the time being. McCarty stated that the Shelley Company which will be paving Rose and May Streets will get with him on an accurate start date for this project. Diane Cowgill asked council why the street signs which had been taken down have not been put back yet. McCarty stated he would look into getting this done. Cowgill also asked about the junk cars with no current tags being towed. McCarty stated that only certain cars would be allowed to be towed as regulated by the Sheriff's Department. McCarty stated he would get with the Sheriff's Department concerning this matter.

In new business McCarty relayed to council a contract with the City of Marysville concerning the squad billing techniques. The contract would require that all information on the squad run sheet be confidential to the village and billing agents. Baughman made a motion to approve the contract with Pierce seconding the motion. All yeas. Verity informed council that a Village Yard Sale will be held on August 8th. Residents wishing to be a part of this are being asked to pay \$2.00 each toward the cost of advertising this event. McCarty stated he would make a list of supplies needed to fix up the benches, and the gazebo at the park. McCarty stated a Mercury Vapor Light at the fire house has gone out. Baughman made a motion for the purchase of parts to repair with Laird seconding the motion. All yeas. McCarty stated he would pick up these supplies. The trees that are overhanging the village sidewalks and alleys are in need of trimming. Council agreed that this is the responsibility of the property owners. Council agreed to walk the streets to possibly get the residents to trim as needed. McCarty informed council that the Issue II application has been turned in but does not look like the village will see any of this money.

Pierce made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Laird seconding the motion. All yeas. The next meeting will be August 13, 1998 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fire House.
