Council Meeting Minutes
March 2, 1994

Mayor called meeting to order. Clerk read minutes from February meeting, Ron made motion to approve minutes as read, 2nd by Bill. Role Call vote, all yeas. Treasurers report was given and bills were presented for payment, Bill made motion to approve Treasurer's report as read and approve bills for payment, 2nd by Carol. Role call vote, all yeas.

NEW BUSINESS:

Joyce McCarty asked for a zoning variance in order to put an hair salon in her home. She stated the it would be a full service salon cuts, perms weaving etc and would be handicap accessible. After some discussion, Ron made motion to grant her the variance, 2nd by Bob. Role call vote, all yeas. Clerk will provide her with a letter stating that the variance was granted.

OLD BUSINESS:

Gary Ledley has not been able to give estimates for street repairs due to the weather, he will have for the April meeting.

Insurance: Criminal acts (a tort) are not covered under this policy, but would cover if wrongfully accused.

Recycling grant: We received the \$1,000 grant but when it will start we are not sure, updates at a later date, until then we need to find a volunteer 1 Saturday a month to oversee the project. If we cannot find one Julie Whipple will help.

Improvements to the Village: Clean all sewer lines & drops?

Marty discussed sewer problems at Dave West's and council discussed what should be done. Options are to either clean line or replace. Ron made motion at Marty's discretion to either clean or replace 2nd by Bob B. Role call vote all yeas. Marty will look into the problem at the south west corner of Park & Rose st.

After discussing the final appropriations, Bill made motion to accept (see attached) 2nd by Ron, Role call vote all yeas.

Vacancies on Zoning board, tabled.

Mosquito Spraying: Bob B. attended a breakfast meeting he found it informative, ^{but} still has questions, will get questions answered.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor ^{contacted} Warner Cable ^{man for} about helping fund trees for the Village after being approached by the 3rd grade class at Leesburg. Warner is willing to help with costs, if school class is willing to plant. Approximately the end of April, council members need to be thinking of where to plant trees.

Carol brought up the park needing flowers, mowing & trimming to be done this summer, any volunteers need to talk to Carol.

Carol attended the Union County Health Dept. 75th year in existence meeting, and gave report of what happened at the meeting.
