

**VILLAGE OF MAGNETIC SPRINGS  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES FOR Nov. 18, 1999**

Council members present were: Kathy Cantrell, Melissa Stiles, Rex Pierce, Carol Verity, Mayor Bill McCarty and Clerk Lorrie Pheifer. Others in attendance were Pam and Gerald Schank, April Thompson, Sally Sloane, and Alan Fitzpatrick. Mayor McCarty brought the meeting to order with the reading of the Oct. 21 minutes. Pierce made a motion to accept the minutes as read with Cantrell seconding the motion. All yeas. The treasurers report was given with a balance of \$67,793.81 total in all village accounts. Stiles made a motion to approve the treasurers report and pay all bills with Cantrell seconding the motion. All yeas.

In Old Business Mayor McCarty asked Verity about the prices on the flags for the village. Flag prices are as follows 36 x 60 - 37.99, Poles and plastic sleeve - 14.99, Brackets with screws - 9.00 @, Decorative flags 3 x 5 - 45.00 2 x3- 24.99, 28 x 44 - 28.99. Verity will count the number needed and get back with council. McCarty stated that the trustees have decided to leave the emergency squad runs as previously billed, \$100.00 for a regular run, \$150.00 for treated run. Fall clean up went well with little on ground. McCarty stated that Leesburg Township and Magnetic received the grant for a new shelterhouse to be built at the ballpark. McCarty stated he would get with Elmer Fuller regarding his rentals on Rose St.

In New Business Mrs. Schank was on hand to ask council if she could start up a neighborhood watch program. Council agreed and voiced their support unanimously. Schank stated she would set up meeting dates and get back with council. McCarty offered the use of the village hall for any meetings that would not conflict with already scheduled meetings. McCarty stated that Sally Sloane would be interested in the clerk's position which will be up March 31, 1999.

Pierce made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Verity seconding the motion. All yeas. The next meeting will be Dec. 16, 1999 at 7:00 p.m. at the Fire House.
